WOWW 10TH ANNUAL YOUTH ART SHOW

Middle & High School Rules and Policies 2023-24

THEME: "ICONIC"

ELIGIBILITY:

The WOWW Youth Art Show is open to all full-time students in grades 6-12 in public or private schools in the Texas Panhandle. This art competition is not affiliated with Texas UIL. The student need not be enrolled in an art class to have his/her work considered for submission but must be supervised and sponsored by a school faculty member.

ORIGINALITY:

All work must be created by the student. The entry must be conceptualized, developed, and completed by the student. If a parent or teacher has any doubt about the originality of the piece, it should not be submitted.

- Using/copying published images is not allowed. This also applies to song lyrics and other published literary works.
- Published material such as newspaper & magazine pages may be used only as textural ground or as collage material. All non-original images used must be re-purposed and/or manipulated well beyond their original form/composition.
- Examples of non-original/copyrighted images includes: comics, licensed characters, artist-rendered illustrations.
- Artwork cannot contain an image of, or make use of, a licensed character(s).
- Students must create the artwork from observation, their imagination, their experiences, or a photograph taken by the student who produced the artwork.
- If non-original/copyrighted images or words are used for inspiration for the artwork, references must be included, and may be subject to disqualification if it is decided that it has not been sufficiently reimagined beyond the original composition.

ENTRIES:

There is no entry fee for the WOWW Youth Art Show.

Any student who participates may enter only ONE work of art.

Artwork must be matted (in black or white) or mounted. Canvas paintings, textiles, and odd shaped paintings do not need mats/mounts.

Two-dimensional artwork cannot exceed 24"x 36", including matting.

Three-dimensional artwork must be able to stand alone. Dimensions cannot exceed 24"x 24" x 36".

Pastels and charcoal must be protected with a fixative spray. We cannot guarantee the protection of the artwork if pastels and charcoal have not been protected with a fixative spray and reserve the right to apply a fixative spray to the artwork, if needed.

We are unable to accept any motion graphics and/or interactive media entries.

No entries will be accepted without the following:

- A fully completed Artwork Form with artist's first and last name, school, grade, medium, title and description of the artwork which MUST be signed and dated by the supervising faculty member, parent, and student. Do not attach the Artwork Form to the artwork. Handwriting must be legible.
- Name, grade, and school securely fixed to the back of the artwork.

Entries must be original to this show. Re-purposed artwork than has been previously submitted to art contests and shows are subject to disqualification.

Artwork must be submitted by mail (PO Box 9258, Amarillo, TX 79105) or in person to the WOWW office at the Globe-News Center for the Performing Arts(500 S Buchanan, Amarillo, TX 79101) by **November1**, **2023.** WOWW will be organizing drop-off locations throughout Region 16 the week of November 1 to receive student artwork: contact the WOWW office for more information.

All artwork will be available to pick up by a student, teacher, or parent at the WOWW office in the Globe-News Center for the Performing Arts any time after December 1, 2023.

CRITERIA:

Artwork evaluation will be based on the following criteria. Each criterion is weighted equally.

1. Creativity and Originality

There is evidence of imagination, creativity, and individuality. The result is distinctive, and the concept presented in a unique way that is imaginative and inventive.

2. Technique

The student chooses and utilizes media and tools competently to enhance the appearance of the work.

3. Organization

The use of elements and the principles of art are used effectively and selectively to enhance the overall appearance of the work.

4. Clarity of Theme

The work combines technique, expression, and organization through artistic and critical judgement to achieve an effective interpretation of the theme.

Judges will have access to the artist's description of the piece of art, and this will be considered in the overall score.

Note: Window On a Wider World and panel of judges have the right to exclude any work from consideration in the contest. The decision of WOWW and the panel of judges is final as relating to all contest matters.

The judges will judge all artwork based on the criteria listed. The winning selections will be made solely on the consensus of the panel of judges.

AWARDS:

There will be two categories of judging: Middle School (grades 6-8) and High School (grades 9-12). Awards will be presented to 10 winners in the Middle School Category and 10 winners in the High School Category. All winners will receive a cash prize and have their artwork displayed at Arts in the Sunset for a free, public exhibition November 13-18, 2023.

- Middle School (6th-8th) Division: \$100 for each of the Top 10 Winners
- High School (9th-12th) Division:

1st Place - \$500 2nd Place - \$300 3rd Place - \$200

\$100 for each of the seven(7) remaining Top 10 Winners

Winners must be present the day of the show or have an appointed parent or school representative present to receive the cash prize. The WOWW office must be contacted prior to the event if no one will be present to receive the cash prize or prize will be forfeited.
